Frank reviewed the new refresher possibility of taking and recording class hours.

Frank talked about the new "Stop the Bleed" information being presented to various community groups if anyone is interested. He felt the auxiliary could do it.

Frank reminded those that didn't remember that the Stryker cot can be made shorter, we need to do a better job of doing triage, when anyone mentions a pounding headache to think about stroke and that intense right arm and right side chest pain may be a contraindication to giving nitro.
