The Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) course is a unique continuing education program created in recognition of the real need in EMS education for additional training in the handling of trauma patients. This program is designed to enhance and increase knowledge and skill in delivering critical trauma care in the pre-hospital environment.

The Goals of PHTLS are:

- To provide a description of the pathophysiology and kinematics of injury
- To provide an understanding of the need for a rapid assessment of the trauma patient
- To advance the participant's level of knowledge in regard to examination and diagnostic skills
- To enhance the participant's performance in the assessment and treatment of the trauma patient
- To advance the participant's level of competence in

regard to specific prehospital trauma intervention skills

To provide an overview and establish a management method for the pre-hospital care of the multi-system trauma patient

- Pediatric assessment and immobilization
